On this the 12TH day of August, 2020, the City of Fairfield, Texas as owner and Lessor (hereinafter called "City") of Moody Fairgrounds and all its improvements and structures, and the Eagle Flag Football, Freestone County, Texas, 75840, as Lessee (hereinafter called "Association"), whose mailing address is P.O. Box 279, Fairfield, Texas 75840, whose contact person is Ashlee Daniel, whose phone number is 626-252-3688, wishes to temporarily occupy and use a portion of the above referenced property in conjunction with other City sponsored activities for the following purposes:

- 1. Flag Football
- 2. Parking
- 3. All other activities and event commonly pertaining to tournaments and events

I.

The following is a list of the property, facilities, structures, and buildings (i.e., "Premises") which form a part of this Lease Agreement ("Agreement"):

- 1. Practice Field behind Ike Carden Arena
- 2. Parking area
- 3. Restrooms, Permanent and Portable

Η.

Association assumes the entire responsibility and liability for any injury or damage to City, its agents, servants and employees, or to third parties or to Association, its agents, servants, employees and officers, and will indemnify and hold harmless the City, its agents, servants and employees from and against any and all losses, expenses, demands and claims against the City, its agents, servants and employees, by any member of the public or any agent, servant, employee or officer of Association's, arising from any source associated with Association's use and occupancy of the Premises, and agrees to defend any suit or action brought against the City based upon any bodily injury, death or property damage, real or

alleged, and to pay all damages, costs and expenses including, attorney's fees, in connection with or resulting from Association's occupancy and use of the Premises.

III.

The City of Fairfield agrees that it shall maintain all water and power connections to facilities, assist in the maintenance of the grounds to include mowing and watering.

IV.

The City retains and reserves unto itself, sole and exclusive authority to grant to third parties any other use or occupancy of any portion of the property together with the right of ingress and egress for such purposes and to have access at anytime to the Premises used and occupied by Association as well as Association's operations thereon. The Association shall not hinder or restrain Premises during the term of this Agreement and the City shall not interfere with any properly conducted Association related operations at the fields.

V.

The Association will donate their time and effort to provide routine maintenance and up keep of the Fairgrounds, and will take care of the general cleanliness of concession stand and bathrooms. The Association will not make any duplicates of keys for facilities and will report and reimburse the loss of any key to the City.

VI.

Association shall not assign or sublet its rights hereunder or create any mortgage on the Premises without first obtaining the prior written consent of the City. Without said consent, this Agreement is void.

VII.

Association shall not place any permanent improvements on the Premises without first obtaining consent of the City, and shall not cut any fence or damage any improvements, permanent or temporary that the City may place thereon.

VIII.

During the term of this Agreement, Association shall carry general liability insurance for the all Association related events at the Premises, in the amount of 1 million dollars.

IX.

Annual insurance includes, but is not limited to, all Association related football, event, and tournament activities.

XII.

The Association shall insure that the Premises are completely cleaned and restored to its condition prior to the event. The Association and City in a combined effort will see that this is done. Any temporary facilities, material or equipment placed on the Premises for the event shall be removed by the Association by the end of the football season.

XIII.

Unless agreed to otherwise in writing during the period of this Agreement, only, Association shall be responsible for booking all events during the football season and will coordinate their scheduling with the City.
